The U.S.- Mexico Foundation’s Dreamers without Borders program takes delegations of DACA recipients of Mexican origin to visit Mexico. The program provides participants with a greater understanding of Mexico’s current reality and the importance of the US-Mexico relationship from multiple angles, while strengthening participant’s pride in their heritage. The Program’s agenda is truly unique and has proven to be a life-changing experience!

We invite you to apply to participate in the December 2016 delegation! Selected beneficiaries will be hosted by the USMF and its partners during a 5-day stay in Mexico City plus 5 days in their state of origin. Additionally, participants will have the opportunity to spend the Holidays with their family.

Applicant eligibility and application requirements:

- Currently enrolled or recently graduated (no more than five years ago) from University or College.
- Currently residing in Chicago, Dallas, Las Vegas, Los Angeles, or New York (Tri-state area)
- From Jalisco, Michoacán, Guanajuato, Guerrero, or Puebla
- Between 20 and 28 years-old
- Left Mexico before the age of 13 years-old
- Have not returned to Mexico since moving to the US.
- DACA valid through January 15th, 2017 or later.
- Submit a personal essay or video and a letter of recommendation.
- Commitment to participate in all activities included in the Program’s agenda while in Mexico
- Is participating or has participated in volunteering activities or community projects (a plus)
- Fill out an application (just click on below button) and submit it along with required documents
- Have not participated in previous Delegations to Mexico sponsored or co-sponsored by the USMF

Program Timeline:

- June 24: Deadline to submit application
- July 15: Announcement of selected beneficiaries
- December 7, 2016 to January 3, 2017: Visit to Mexico

The USMF will issue an acceptance letter to those selected to participate, inviting them to join this unique Cultural and Educational Program, which they will be able to use to make scheduling arrangements with their school or work.
