






# Diverse Books for the ELL Classroom

## What diverse books mean to our students-




All Children should be able to see themselves in the stories they hear and read.







## More than Caldecott

#### Caldecott Medal

Honors the artist of the most distinguished American picture book for children.

#### **Newbery Medal**

Honors the author of the most distinguished contribution to American literature for children.

#### **Batchelder Award**

Given to an American publisher for a children's book published outside the United States, and subsequently translated into English.

#### Coretta Scott King (Illustrator)

Recognizing an African American Illustrator of outstanding books for children

#### Belpré Medal (Illustrator)


Honors a Latino/Latina illustrator whose works best portray, affirm, and celebrate the Latino cultural experience in an outstanding work of literature for children and youth.


#### **Geisel Medal**

Honors the author(s) and illustrator(s) of the most distinguished contribution to the body of American children's literature known as beginning reader books.




