- Yellow and Green = Left Early





- Time to Complete a Task






Random Group Creator

- The teacher is able to create random groups.
- Class Dojo uses the students enrolled in the class to randomly generate groups based on the number of students the teachers wants in each group.

- Choosing a Center/Activity




Think-Pair-Share Tool

- Some questions are provided or the teacher can create their own.








Home Communication


- Class Story, School Story, Student Portfolios, and Messaging





Average grade levels of quizzes taken by students in this class





Grade Level Progression


Grade level for each quiz taken

Lexile text measures of the passages read by the student








Classroom Screen
